As Law Enforcement, Service Providers, and/or Victim Assistance Professionals, these are necessary steps we may be coming alongside families of victims as they must decide and plan.

- Notifying family and friends of your death
- Identifying your body
- Dealing with the religious or cultural issues your death raises with your family
- Informing law enforcement officials or victim services professionals of any spiritual or cultural timelines, taboos or requirements of your family
- Making the cremation/funeral/burial arrangements
- Reviewing and paying the medical bills
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- Dealing with the Court Process
